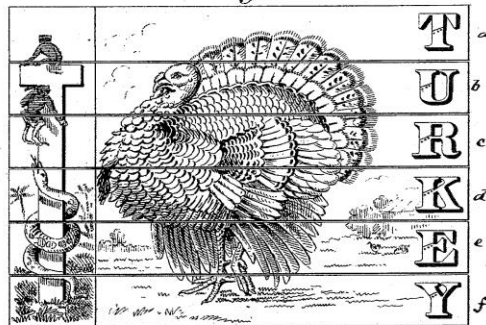
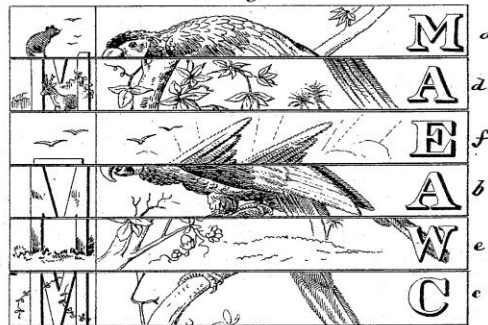

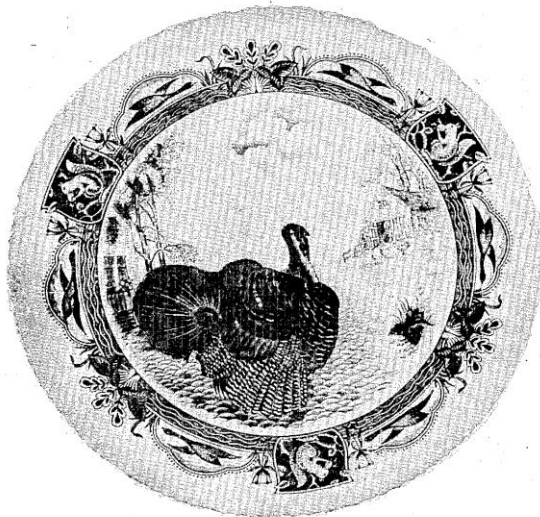

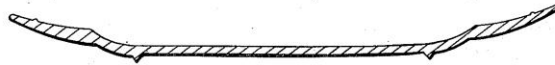

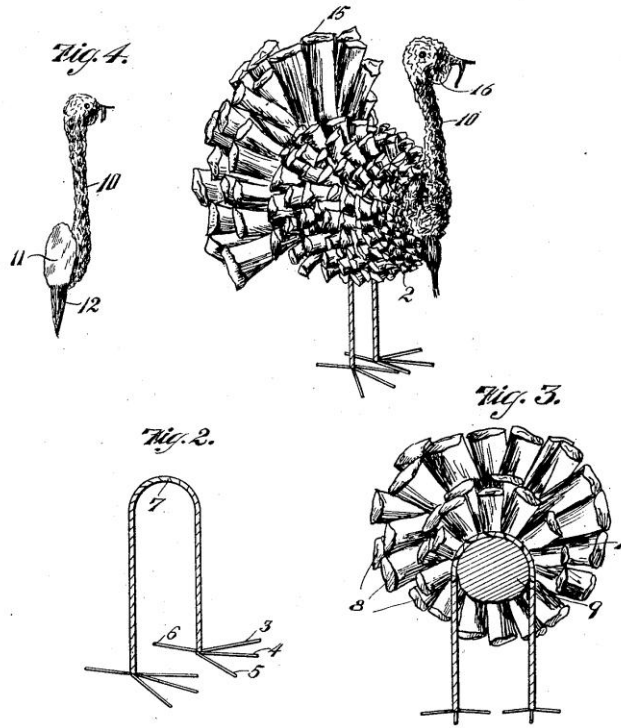

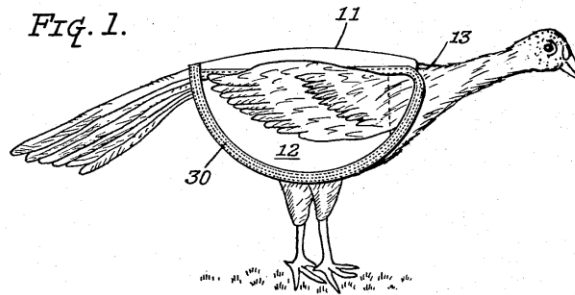

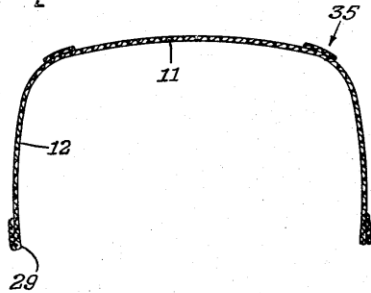

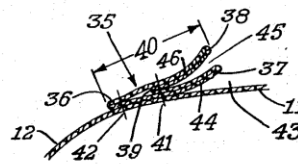
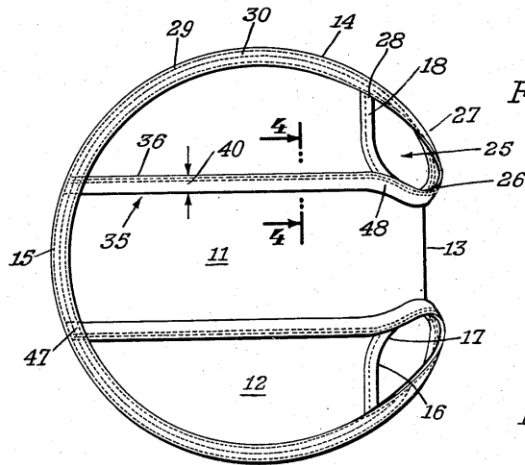

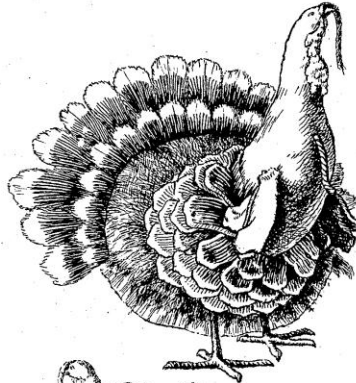

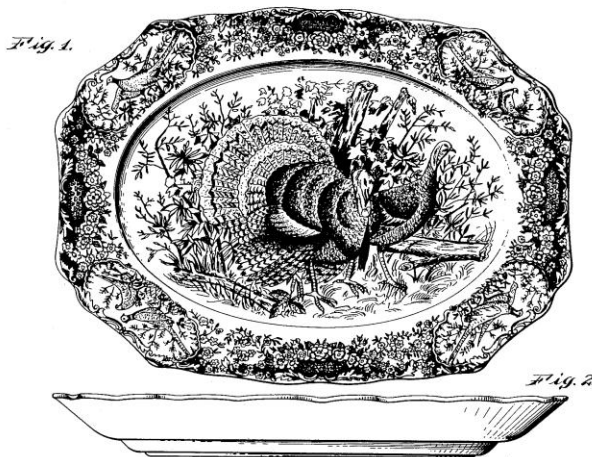

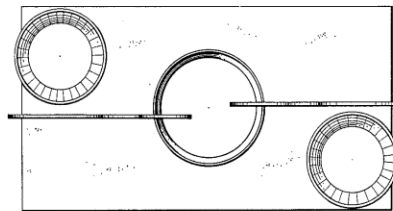

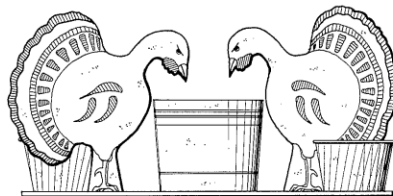


Figure 1 is a top plan view of a tray or similar article showing by new design; and
